

Bringing a boat to Fallen Leaf?

- We hope having your boat with you at Camp will add to your enjoyment! While here at the Lake, we ask that you use courteous and safe boating practices and that you abide by the rules and the water-ski patterns set forth by the Fallen Leaf Lake Ski Association. In addition, we ask that you pay special attention to *the newly marked safety zone in the Camp waterfront area*, remembering to enter and exit this multi-use area at a speed of *no more than 5 miles per hour*.
- While we do not currently ask for a boat mooring fee, we do ask that you clearly understand our limited boat storage situation and the added responsibilities associated with bringing a boat to Camp. We also ask that noise and skiing/boating paraphernalia not infringe upon the enjoyment of the vacations of other Camp guests and Fallen Leaf residents. In particular, please be aware of early morning noise. Please remember that all but hand-carried boats must be launched at the Fallen Leaf Marina for a Launch fee.
- Please remember that all two-stroke engines have been banned from Lake Tahoe and all tributary waters in the Tahoe Basin. This ban includes the vast majority of personal watercraft. Any further questions should be directed to the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency at (775) 588-4547.
- Please come prepared with your own supply of life preservers, ropes, paddles, etc. as we can not dispense Camp gear for use on guest boats.
- Camp does **not** assume any responsibility for damage that may occur to guest boats, nor does it assume any responsibility for injury to guests in the event of accidents.

Remember that space at Camp is assigned on a first-come, first-serve basis.
